

FIREWORKS PERMIT

Pursuant to s. 167.10(3), no person may possess or use fireworks without a user's permit issued by the chairperson of the town in which the possession or use is to occur.

Fireworks that require a permit

Fireworks that require a permit include, but are not limited to roman candles, firecrackers, bottle rockets, mortars, etc. (generally anything that leaves the ground or explodes) is a regulated "firework" such that a person must have a local government issued permit to use or possess them.

A permit is necessary for and only allows possession and use of the fireworks within the municipality where the permit is issued. The town chair issues the fireworks permit.
