ORDINANCE NUMBER 3

Ordinance

Town of Scott

The Town Board of the Town of Scott, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

That any and all roads to be hereinafter accepted as part of the town road system shall be required to meet the following specifications:

1. Minimum right of way shall be four (4) rods.
2. Minimum width of roadbed shall be thirty (30) feet.
3. Minimum width of hard surface (bituminous to be twenty (20) feet, over a gravel base of (1000) yards per mile, for an average depth of four (4) inches.
4. Such bridges and/or culverts as deemed necessary by the town board shall be installed.
5. All dead-end roads shall have a sixty (60) foot diameter cleared turn around area.
6. All cuts and fills shall have no less than one to one grade.
7. All roads shall meet approval by inspection of the town board and the County Highway Department.
8. All roads shall further meet standards set by Wis. Stat. 86.28 (#3 100 to 250 A.D.T.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the town board of the Town of Scott on June 4 - 1980.
