Lincoln County

The Town Board of the Town of Scott does hereby adopt Ordinance 2017-03 designating the following town roads as snowmobile and all-terrain vehicle routes in accordance with Section 350.04 and Section 23.33(8) of Wisconsin Statutes.

- From the driveway located at N1025 Scott Road in a Southerly direction approximately 1/8 mile.
- The West end of Heldt Street for approximately 3/8 mile to lands currently owned by Diana (Sukow) Williams.
- Wood Avenue for approximately 3/8 mile to lands currently owned by Keith Kolbe at W6431 Wood Avenue.

This ordinance is in effect only during the winter snowmobiling season and only after trails are officially opened by the Lincoln County Snowmobile Council in accordance with the Lincoln County Snowmobile Trail Ordinance.

It is understood that the routes containing the above-mentioned town roads will be properly signed by the Devils Creek Stump Jumpers, Inc. Snowmobile Club in accordance with all state and county laws and regulations.

This ordinance is effective upon posting and shall remain in effect until further action by the board.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
