Lincoln County

The Town of Scott Town Board, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, has specific authority under Section 7.30(1) Wis. Stats. to adopt this ordinance.

While Section 7.30(1) Wis. Stats requires that there shall be a minimum of seven election inspectors for each polling place at each election, it further authorizes that a municipal governing body may reduce the number of inspectors to five.

The Scott Town Board authorizes the Town Clerk to decide how many election inspectors will be needed at any given election and to schedule those inspectors accordingly, so long as the town is following Section 7.30(1) Wis. Stats.
