Adopting Supervisory District Lines to Create Wards for the Town of Scott

STATE OF WISCONSIN

LINCOLN COUNTY

WHEREAS, Section 5.15(1) of the Wisconsin Statutes requires that a municipality be divided into wards to "permit creation of supervisory districts of substantially equal population or to enhance the participation of members of a racial or language minority group in the political process and their ability to elect representatives of their choice"; and,

WHEREAS, the Tentative Lincoln County Supervisory District Plan, adopted via Lincoln County Resolution 2021-09-39, on September 21, 2021, by the Lincoln County Board of Supervisors, has been submitted to and reviewed by the Scott Town Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Scott establish wards conforming to the Tentative Lincoln County Supervisory District Plan, a copy of which is attached; and,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Wards 1 and 2 be combined for the purposes of voting and reporting election results when voting for the same offices; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the polling place for Wards 1 and 2 be the Scott Town Hall, located at N563 Lake Road, Merrill, Wisconsin.
